The upscale address of Cleverdale, New York boasts one restaurant and it is the haunt of all the locals. Sans Souci is a comfortable pub with something to offer the entire family.

Sans Souci is in a one-hundred-year-old, nicely renovated building. The sports bar is located in the back of the restaurant, separate from the dining area. The dining room has a fabulous pool table that is a definite crowd pleaser. There is an upbeat fun, yet relaxed vibe throughout Sans Souci. Whether shooting pool, playing

your favorite songs on the state-of-the-art juke box or watching the game, it is all about chilling out. One of the greatest features is their downstairs game room and pizza bar. Mom and Dad can enjoy a quiet dinner upstairs, while the kids eat downstairs and play video games to their heart's content. What kid, and for that matter parent, would not love that? Apparently during the busy summer season 5:00-9:00pm is referred to as the sandbox—families come in for dinner and the kids head downstairs to the game area. Couples tend to dine from 9-11pm, and

from 11:00pm-2:00am the party crowd descends on Sans Souci.

The Sans Souci menu offers a plethora of terrific pub fare, pizza, and nightly specials. They also feature fabulous entrées such as steak au poivre and chicken parmesan. Various evenings have specific themes including Thursday's prime rib night, and comfort Sunday. We went to Sans

Souci on an arctic evening and decided to begin our meal with soup. The French onion beckoned me, and the seafood chowder called to my companion. My crock of French onion soup was bubbling over with oozing cheese and was savory and delicious. My companion's seafood chowder was chock-full of fresh seafood including clams, mussels and shrimp, all in a creamy palate pleasing broth. Both soups were winners. My companion then indulged in Sans Souci's colossal shrimp cocktail. When they say colossal shrimp, they aren't kidding. The shrimp was served on a bed of greens and a pool of homemade cocktail sauce. My companion raved about this appetizer. The shrimp were so plump and fresh and the cocktail sauce was just to his liking. Being a lover of fish and chips I had no problem deciding on my entrée, and the build a burger sounded ideal to my companion. My fish was a full haddock filet, complete with plenty of chips, cole slaw, and tartar sauce. My fish and chips were perfectly fried to a golden brown and incredibly tasty. The fish was of the highest quality, and the amount so generous I could not finish. My companion's burger was charbroiled to a perfect medium, served on a grilled hard roll with lettuce, tomato, mayo, and the cheddar cheese and mushrooms, per request. His entrée came with fries and a pickle. In my book, a good burger is hard to beat, and this was a really good burger!
