**Success Magazine: You have given new life to Tiny Tots Tea Room. How did you come to purchase the business?**

Sari Medick: I had the wonderful opportunity to meet Kate (the previous owner) prior to her opening Tiny Tots four years ago. After sharing with her that I had had fifteen years of experience in the kids' entertainment industry and a lifetime of experience in event planning and catering, we really hit it off. When she asked me to come help out at Tiny Tots last October, I was excited about the opportunity. On my first day, Kate found out she was expecting. Over the course of the next few months our friendship grew stronger. In May she approached me about purchasing, and I whole heartedly said yes! I was bursting at the seams to put all my experience into a place like this. I ran Tiny Tots for Kate in June while I began plotting for a busy summer. I truly have only improved upon what was already here, and it has made an amazing difference!

**SM: What did you accomplish this summer that you are proud of?**

Sari: First and foremost, we pushed hard in June and took the Number One Indoor Play Place and the Number Two Place in the Capital Region by voters of KidsOutandAbout.com. Not to mention, we sold 256 Groupon's and almost a dozen Success Coupons so far. And, of course, Facebook—we have gone from 300 to 520 friends since July.

**SM: What ages are welcome to play at Tiny Tots Tea Room? What are some of the events that you offer?**

Sari: Tiny Tots Tea Room is open to all ages. The main playroom is designed for ages nine months to six years. We offer a full-service café (no outside food is permitted) for our parents. Our baked goods and soups are all made on-site. A gluten- and dairy-free menu is available as well.

Each month we hold Parents' Night Out, we have a Halloween party coming soon, and vendor nights in November and December. We are home to Mothers and
